Salvador

The name means “savior,” and it was actually the first capital of Brazil (the current Brazilian capital is Brasilia). Salvador is the capital of the enormous state of Bahia. This quaint yet prodigious city is the site of colonial style houses and beautiful old catholic churches. It has a rich cultural heritage of African, Native Indians, and Portuguese mixture. It boasts the Pelourinho, an adorable historical landmark that is best compared to Charleston, South Carolina, New Orleans, Louisiana, or Beaufort, South Carolina. In fact, UNESCO declared the Pelourinho a World Heritage Cultural Site.

The city was founded in 1549, after the Portuguese discovered Brazil. The bay offered a safe place to anchor the boats, and garnered the attention of the sailors. Salvador, became the first Capital of Brazil and had that title until 1763, the year that the capital was moved to Rio de Janeiro. Salvador was a very important city for defending the coast. The Portuguese built a fort at the top of the hill, so they could see the ships away using their strategic position.

The construction of the new metropolis followed well-defined plans that may be recognized in the urban space that nowadays is occupied by the Historical Center - main public and

religious buildings were protected in the higher part of the city. Even though, Salvador underwent the Dutch occupation for some months in 1624, a new attack of the same Dutch in 1638 was not successful. Invaders were repelled immediately.

Salvador is the city where music, capoeira, food and buildings that are part of Brazil's cultural roots are preserved and taken to the streets to be shared with visitors. To walk along the Historical Center, especially through old alleys and squares of Pelourinho neighborhood, is to observe constructions of the XVIII and XIX centuries. Over here, the way people show their happiness is celebrating on the street.



Fortaleza

To know Fortaleza is to go on a trip its history. The city is modernized, but it still keeps signs from the past in its museums, churches, fortresses, squares, stations, theaters, and historic buildings. The city center is filled with those memories, such as the Fortress of Nossa Senhora da Assunção, built on the same place where the city originated, and the Luz Palace, a beautiful construction in classic style from the end of the 18th century, which used to be the State Government headquarters.

However, going to the beaches is, without a doubt, one of the best activities for those coming to Fortaleza. Iracema, Meireles, and Futuro Beaches are among the most popular options within the city.

To walk on the Beira Mar Avenue promenade from the start, at Mucuripe, up to the Ingleses Bridge, at Iracema Beach, is a must-do walk, and quite reinvigorating. Boat trips by the beach margins are offered at tourist spots and are ideal for those wishing to enjoy a panoramic view of the capital.

The city has a physical structure able to cater to any type of event, local and international. Ease of access to the airport, flights available to many Brazilian regions and other countries, and the privileged location make the State a natural choice for organizers of fairs, conferences, and events. Add to that the many tourism attractions that, offering first class entertainment for the tourists, this is one of the top must-see places in Brazil.
